



Wisconsin Professional Credential for Preschool Teachers

The courses in this exciting professional credential are part of the Associate Degree program. Five courses have been selected from the Wisconsin Technical College System Statewide Curriculum to comprise **The Wisconsin Professional Credential for Preschool Teachers**. The classes listed below will meet the requirements of the credential until the statewide curriculum is implemented.

A practicum experience is not included in this credential as most colleges require that a student be enrolled in an Associate or Bachelors Degree program to participate in a practicum experience.

The credential will have a commission process as in The Registry's other professional credentials. The portfolio will be based on the Program Standards from The National Association for the Education of Young Children and activities that may be assigned by instructors of the courses.
