STARTING DATE: August – First Year
June – Second Year

LENGTH OF PROGRAM: Technical Diploma – One Year (31-404-3)
Technical Diploma – Two Year (32-404-2)

All applicants, whether interested in the one- or two-year program, must apply to the one-year Automotive Maintenance Technician program (see ***Steps for Admission*** below). There is either a daytime option or PM option. Individuals interested in the two-year Automotive Technician program will be given an opportunity during the second semester of their first year to indicate an interest in completing the second year. A limited number of slots will be available for the second year (see ***Selection Process...*** below).

I. STEPS FOR ADMISSION:

1. **Submit [Application for Admission](#) for the one-year Automotive Maintenance Technician program (Daytime or PM).**
2. **Pay \$30 application processing fee – this must be paid *at time of application***
3. **Education Requirement*: Applicants who did not graduate from high school, are not currently high school seniors, and did not receive an HSED or GED diploma must complete the following:**

A COMPASS[®] pre-entry Ability to Benefit assessment:

- Achieve scores of at least 25 in math, 62 in reading, and 32 in writing.

***Note:** If you have an international diploma or degree, additional admission requirements may apply.

4. **COMPASS[®] Pre-entry Assessment.** COMPASS[®] is an un-timed, computerized test of **reading** and **pre-algebra**. Scores are used for advisement purposes.

If you do not have access to the internet, please contact the Assessment Center at 1-800-547-2882 or 715-833-6200.
 - **Substitutions of the COMPASS[®]** will be made for those that can provide proof of one of the following:
 - ~ **ACT[®]** : Applicants must achieve a minimum composite score of **18** on the ACT[®] . Reading and Math scores are required for class placement and advisement purposes only – no minimum. If the ACT[®] composite score does not meet the minimum, applicants will need to take the COMPASS[®] pre-entry assessment.
 - ~ **Associate Degree, Bachelor’s Degree or higher:** A transcript is required showing proof of degree awarded.

Once all the above items have been completed, you will be considered for enrollment based on current openings in the one-year technical diploma program. It is to your benefit to apply on-line (**[Application for Admission](#)**) and complete all required items as soon as possible.

II. SELECTION PROCESS FOR 2ND YEAR OF THE 2-YEAR PROGRAM:

- Applicants interested in continuing into the second year of the Automotive Maintenance Technician program will declare their intent by [submitting an application](#) during the last two weeks in February of the one-year program. Information on declaring intent to enroll into the second year will be provided to students at the beginning of the second semester. A minimum of 14 students will be selected to proceed to the second year of the Automotive Maintenance Technician program.
- Consideration for “provisional” acceptance will be given to students who complete all of the following courses with a “C” grade or better.

602-110 Basic Vehicle Maintenance	602-113 Automotive Chassis Electricity
602-111 Automotive DC Electricity	442-313 Welding-Automotive Technician
602-112 Intro to Automotive chassis Systems	804-360C Math for Technical Trades

- Of those provisionally accepted, final selection will be based on a “C” grade or better in all of the following second semester courses:

602-120 Advanced Automotive Chassis Systems	602-122 Automotive Computer Systems
602-121 Automotive Engine Performance	801-351 Applied Communications
- Tie-breaker - Date of initial application to the one-year program will be used in cases of identical selection criteria.

NOTES:

This program operates on a year-round basis; therefore, summer session attendance is required in addition to regular school year attendance. **Students that receive financial aid must reapply for financial aid for the summer session.**
- ▶ **Transfer Credit:** Applicants with postsecondary credits should submit an official transcript for evaluation and possible transfer credit.
