- Eligibility for advanced placement requires a person to be a graduate of a two-year ARRT accredited Radiography program.
- Applicants currently enrolled in a two-year ARRT accredited Radiography program may apply after completing their first full year of the program. An official transcript showing completion of the first year is required.
- Graduates of an Associate Degree Nursing program may be considered on a case-by-case basis for acceptance. Before applying contact a program counselor at (715) 833-6346 or (800) 547-2882, extension 6346.

LENGTH OF PROGRAM: Associate Degree – 2 Years

STEPS FOR ADMISSION:

1. Submit [Application for Admission](#)
2. Pay \$30 application processing fee
3. Students that did not graduate from high school must provide one of the following:
 - copy of high school equivalency diploma (HSED) OR
 - copy of Certificate of General Education Development (GED)
4. Submit official transcript(s) of your postsecondary education in the Radiography or Registered Nursing field.
5. Submit a transcript verifying graduation from a Radiography or RN-nursing program
6. Submit proof of registration/certification in a Radiography or RN-nursing field
7. Submit a completed Background Information Disclosure Form, the Wisconsin Criminal History Single Name Record Request Form and an \$18.00 background processing fee. These forms are available on the web at <http://www.cvtc.edu/apps/Catalog/CareGiver/CaregiverInst.htm> or can be supplied to the student by CVTC.

Applications are considered on a first-come, first-completed basis; therefore, it is to your benefit to complete the required items as soon as possible. Once all of these items have been completed, you will be considered for enrollment based on current openings in the program.

Additional requirements for this program:

- Proof of CPR-Certification by the American Heart Association - Healthcare Provider Level or the American Red Cross - Professional Rescuer Level must be on file before entering core courses of the program.
- A *Pre-Entrance Health History and Physical Examination* must be on file three weeks prior to entering the core program courses. The Admissions Office will notify you at the appropriate time with a specified deadline.
- Students can expect to apply and interview in clinical training sites throughout Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa and Illinois.

PREGNANCY POLICY

Upon learning of a pregnancy, it is the student's responsibility to notify the program faculty. The student may continue with the program under the following conditions to protect the mother and child.

1. Student must submit a physician's written authorization to the faculty.
2. After delivery the student will be readmitted to the program with a physician's written authorization.
3. Student is required to make up all clinical hours missed until all necessary course competencies are complete.
