## ***Course Descriptions***

---

### **307-156 External Environment, ECE** (3 credits)

Review of early care and education programs including determination of community child care needs, marketing, laws and regulations, working with government and community agencies, and political and societal issues and trends.

### **307-424 Fundamentals of Family Child Care** (6 hours)

This course covers the business aspects of child care including recordkeeping, contracts, and specific topics that are fundamental for a family provider. This course can be taken by all in-home child care providers, experienced or not, and the individual responsible for the program's financial records. All course supplies are included. Completion of (307-422) Intro to Child Care Prof-Mod A and this course (307-424) Fundamentals of Family Child Care meets the FDC requirement for a county certified in-home child care business.

### **307-433 Fundamentals of Infant & Toddler Care** (20 hours)

Required for day care providers caring for infants and toddlers. Understand factors affecting need for this care, identification of quality characteristics, developmental activities, planning, health and safety, and basic care. Book purchase required.

### **307-422 Intro to the Child Care Profession, Mod A** (15 hours)

Beginning course for anyone interested in caring for children at home. This course includes the following topics: child growth and development, positive discipline, child abuse and neglect, interpersonal relationships, daily schedule, SIDS prevention, and health, safety and nutrition. Book purchase required. Completion of (307-422) Intro to Child Care Prof, Mod A and (307-424) Fundamentals of Family Child Care meets the FDC requirement for a county certified in-home child care business.

### **307-423 Intro to the Child Care Profession, Module B** (21 hours)

This course expands the knowledge and skills necessary for a home-centered child care business. This course will help you determine your policies and budget, observation and environment planning, positive guidance, relationships, developmentally appropriate activity planning and scheduling. Book purchase required.

Prerequisites: (307-422) Intro to Child Care Prof, Mod A (or concurrent)

Completion of (307-422) Intro to Child Care Prof, Mod A, (307-423) Intro to Child Care Prof, Mod B and (307-424) Fund of Family Child Care meets the FDC certification and licensing requirements of becoming a state licensed in-home child care provider

Completion of (307-422) Intro to Child Care Prof, Mod A and (307-423) Intro to Child Care Prof, Mod B meets the Wisconsin educational requirements for a group center assistant child care teacher.

### **307-153 Operations Management ECE** (3 credits)

Discussion and practical applications related to scheduling, facility management, staffing, equipment acquisition and maintenance, service delivery, recordkeeping, and communication. This course is one of 6 courses required for the Child Care Administrator Credential Certificate.

### **307-426 Shaken Baby Syndrome & SIDS** (6 hours)

This class meets the requirements for certified and licensed early childhood daycare providers and early education professionals. Topics of study will include Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) and Shaken Baby Syndrome. Shaken Baby Syndrome & SIDS are included in 307-422 Intro to the Child Care Profession, Mod A. There is no need to take both classes.
