2010 Knots & Rigging Safety Seminar

A seminar for lineworkers to update their skills and technology in the field of ropes, knots, and rigging safety.

PROGRAM:

The seminar will start with the basics and work into the more complicated and technical knots for today's utility lineworker.

After completion of this course the student will understand the applications to install temporary anchorage and straighten a leaning pole, stabilize a broken pole in order to climb, rig a safety line to work from an elevated location, participate in the climbing of a "unclimbable" pole with safe climb practices, review appropriate rigging for various pole-top rescue procedures, and review and participate in emergency bucket truck evacuation rigging procedures.

Participants will be tested on their proficiency. They will perform rope and rigging inspection and review JSA for each task.

The participations in the course will tie and rig using the appropriate knots, hitches, and rigging to accomplish the key topics.

Key Topics:

- Rig to install a pole in inaccessible area
- Install and change transformers
- Straighten leaning poles
- Procedures for safe climb of hazard poles
- Procedures to perform bucket and pole top rescue

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE: Line crews are constantly required to use ropes, blocks, and other special equipment to raise and lower electrical components, tools, and equipment. In order to perform these tasks safely and efficiently, a fundamental knowledge of rigging and rigging equipment is necessary. This program concentrates on the basics of overhead rigging, including safe rigging practices, ropes, knots and knot tying, the use of hand lines, and the use of blocks and tackle.

WHAT TO BRING: Attendees should bring climbing gear and appropriate PPE in addition to the following items:

- Pen/pencil/notepad
- Hard hat
- Safety glasses
- Belt and hooks
- Gloves (mandatory)
- Climbing boots
