What is a Business & Industry Trainer?

A Business & Industry Trainer collaborates with businesses to develop and administer [customized training](#) or [professional development seminars](#) for employees in a particular field as needed. CVTC works with businesses throughout its [11-county district](#) to provide valuable training designed to enhance employee skills and productivity. These training sessions are held either at one of CVTC's campuses or at the company's location. Business & Industry training assignments offer a great deal of flexibility. In order to be considered for Business & Industry Training, a completed adjunct application to the college is required.

Application Process
