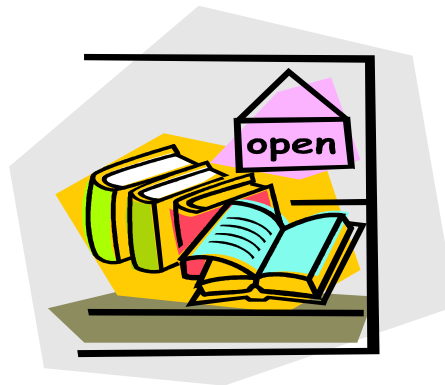
The ESL/ELL lab is available M-F each week during the semester.

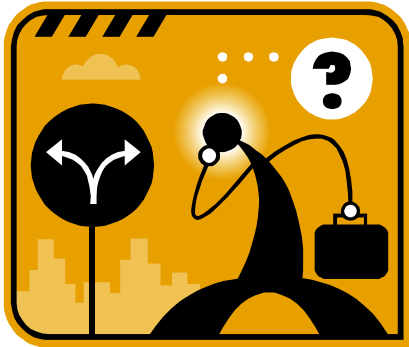
