- Subsidized Stafford Loan:** This loan is awarded based on "financial need". The interest on the loan is paid by the federal government while student is enrolled at least half-time and during the six month grace period.
Unsubsidized Stafford Loan: This loan is not awarded on the basis of need. Student is responsible for interest from the time the loan is disbursed. If interest payments are not made while in school, interest will be added to the principal amount of loan and additional interest will be based on higher amount.
- Additional Unsubsidized Stafford Loan - maximum of \$2,000.00:** This loan is available to dependent students.
- Additional Unsubsidized Stafford Loan - maximum of \$6,000.00:** If you are considered an **independent** student for financial aid purposes, you may be eligible for this loan. Student is responsible for interest from the time the loan is disbursed. If interest payments are not made while in school, interest is will be added to the principal amount of loan and additional interest will be based on higher amount.
- Work Study:** (CVTC employment) Wages are \$8.50 per hour, not to exceed 20 hours per week.
