 Hotel and Restaurant Management (CVTC)**

Chippewa Valley Technical College offers the two – year Hotel and Restaurant Management. Cardinal Stritch University agrees to accept the courses from the Hotel and Restaurant Management as listed in this agreement for equivalency or direct transfer into Management, Business Administration, Strategic Management Information Systems, Human Services Management. Graduates who qualify for admission as a transfer student will be granted transfer credit as listed in this agreement.

Eligibility for participation:

1. Meet the general admission requirements to Cardinal Stritch.
2. Earn a minimum of a 2.0 GPA with a C in each course. This will include grades from only those courses that were repeated and resulted in a final grade of C-.
3. Technical College courses taken outside the stipulated program course will be considered but not automatically accepted for transfer.
4. Each institution will annually review the course alignment and confirm with the appropriate designee the continuance of this agreement.
