

Information about BS Degree Completion with Mankato

- 1) Need minimum of 120 credits between 2 institutions
- 2) Need 40 credits of General Education (Liberal Arts) in 10 different Categories OR need to complete an Associate of Arts degree at WI institution
- 3) Need a minimum of 40 upper division credits – at this time we substitute through our program 8 of these credits from the WI institution.
- 4) Need a minimum of 30 MSU credits to receive a degree from MSU, Mankato. Our current degree completion program is 32 credits of upper division courses.
