CPR Certification

Current CPR certification is required of CVTC applicants in this health care program. The following CPR cards accepted by CVTC:

- American Heart Association **Healthcare Provider** or
- American Red Cross **CPR for the Professional Rescuer**.

Your CPR training must include the following:

- Cognitive and psychomotor objectives
- The links in the chain of survival
- The steps of CPR
- The five major emergencies in adults
- Strategies to prevent sudden infant death syndrome in infants and injuries in children
- Activation of the emergency response system
- Rescue breathing using mouth-to-mouth ventilation, mouth-to-barrier device ventilation, bag-mask ventilation for adult, infant and child victims
- One- and two-rescuer CPR for adult, infant and child victims
- Use of an AED for victims within the guidelines
- Relief of FBAO (Foreign Body Airways Obstruction) in the responsive and unresponsive victim of any age.

If you presently have this certification, it is important that you keep it current. If you are not currently certified, obtain this certification through a local health agency of your choice. If you wish to obtain certification through CVTC, call 715-833-6487 or 1-800-518-8211 to register. **You will be responsible for keeping your certification current throughout your enrollment at CVTC.**

If you have previously completed your CPR training under a title other than the American Heart Association **Healthcare Provider** or the American Red Cross **CPR for the Professional Rescuer**, you must contact the Admissions office to see if your current CPR training will meet the curricula for admittance to CVTC health programs.
