**VERIFICATION of VALID DRIVER'S (Operator's) LICENSE
AND
CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE TESTING**

A copy of my driver's license (operator's) is attached.

Driver's License/Driving History

I understand that:

- I must have a valid driver's license to participate in the Truck Driving program at Chippewa Valley Technical College.
- Driving convictions, such as operating a vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs, may prevent me from employment in the truck driving field.
- I must inform Chippewa Valley Technical College if my driver's license is revoked during the course of the program and that I will be dropped from the Truck Driving program at that time.

Controlled Substances

Initial Testing - I understand that:

- A Department of Transportation (DOT) controlled substance test is required by federal law in order for me to participate in the Truck Driving program.
- The initial testing is at my expense and is to be administered by a laboratory certified by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.
- Proof of completion of the DOT drug test must be on file with the CVTC Human Resources Office prior to operating a College vehicle.
- The test results are only good for a period of six months prior to the first day of classes.

Random Testing – I understand that:

- I may also be selected for random drug and alcohol testing once the program has begun.
- A "negative" test result is required for continuation in the program.
- I will be dismissed from the program, if a "positive" test result occurs.
- If selected for random testing, it will be at the expense of Chippewa Valley Technical College.
