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## REQUEST FOR ADVANCED STANDING CREDIT *Developed through High School Articulation Agreements*

Through agreements between high school districts and Chippewa Valley Technical College (CVTC), students may receive advanced standing credit for certain college courses for competencies they learned in specified high school courses. Students will not be charged fees nor be tested in order to receive advanced standing credit. Criteria that must be met to qualify for advanced standing credit are as follows:

- 1) Students must earn a "B" grade or higher in the necessary high school course(s).
- 2) Students must apply for program admission and submit a high school transcript.
- 3) Students must be accepted into a CVTC program.
- 4) Students must complete this form and submit it to CVTC Admissions Office.
