CVTC and Your High School Might Have an Agreement

If your high school has an agreement with CVTC, certain courses for which you earned a B or better in high school will transfer. See the chart in this brochure and then go to www.cvtc.edu/pages/1191.asp for the most current information on agreements with your high school. You'll need to complete a form (printed next to the "Application for Admission" page in the CVTC catalog) called "Request for Advanced Standing Credit." Or go to www.cvtc.edu/PDFFiles/Registration/ASRequest.pdf to print out and complete this form for the CVTC Registrar.

CVTC Accepts Credits From Wisconsin Youth Apprenticeships and State Certified Skills Co-ops

If you've completed a youth apprenticeship through the state of Wisconsin, we'll probably be able to give you credit if your technical college major is similar. You'll need to present an apprenticeship completion certificate to the CVTC Registrar. Transfer credit is also accepted for the State Certified Agriculture and Business and Information Technology Co-ops.

Ever Consider Testing Out?

You can receive CVTC credits by passing proficiency exams designed for specific CVTC courses. There are limits on how often you can retake the exam and there is a non-refundable fee of 25% of course tuition. Students may also receive CVTC credits by earning a score of 3 or higher on Advanced Placement (AP) tests. Call 715-833-6200 or the CVTC Assessment Center at 715-833-6346 for more information.

Youth Options, Go To CVTC and High School Too!

Eligible high school juniors and seniors at public high schools can attend classes and earn credits at CVTC. Those credits can apply to both high school and technical college credit requirements. Students should apply to their local school board for the fall semester by March 1 of the previous semester, and by October 1 for the spring semester. Call your local high school for specific timelines. Meet with your local high school counselor early to allow time to select the technical college courses that are right for you. It is recommended that prospective Youth Options students take the COMPASS assessment as part of applying for Youth Options classes at CVTC.

A Word About University Transfer Credit

Enrolling at Chippewa Valley Technical College and taking courses can be the first step on a path leading to a university degree. If you plan to eventually transfer technical college credits to a bachelor's degree, please contact that college or university. Know all the requirements and prepare for admission.
